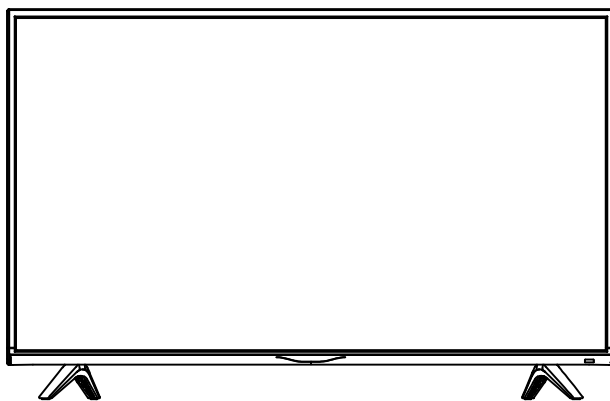

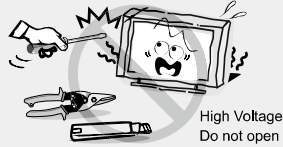

## Important Safety Instructions and Maintenance

### Important Safety Instructions



#### **CAUTION**

Risk of electronic shock, do not open. Do not attempt to service this product yourself as opening or removing covers may expose you to dangerous voltage or other hazards. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this product to rain or moisture. The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.



The screen and cabinet get warm when the TV is in use. This is not a malfunction. In case of smoke, strange noise or strange smell from the unit:

- Turn off the power switch immediately;
- Disconnect the power plug from the power outlet;
- Contact your dealer or service centre. Never attempt to make repairs yourself because this could be dangerous.



If the following problems occur:

Turn off the TV set and unplug the AC power cord immediately if any of the following problems occur. Ask your dealer or service centre to have it checked by qualified service personnel.

When:

- AC power cord is damaged.
- Poor fitting of AC power outlet.
- TV set is damaged by being dropped, hit or having something thrown at it.
- Any liquid or solid object falls through openings in the cabinet.

Never push objects of any kind into the set through the cabinet slots as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short-circuit parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill liquid of any kind on the set. Use special caution in households where children are present. The apparatus is not suitable for children under 3-year to operate.



Do not overload wall outlets, extension cords or adaptors beyond their capacity, this can result in fire or electrical shock. Power-supply cords should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items placed upon or against them, paying particular attention to cords at plug

end, adaptors and the point where they exit from the appliance. The mains plug is used as the disconnect device. It shall remain readily accessible and should not be obstructed during intended use. Make sure to plug the power cord in until it is firmly inserted. When removing the power cord, make sure to hold the power plug when pulling the plug from the outlet, do not pull the plug out by the wire. NEVER touch the plug or power cord with wet hands. To disconnect the apparatus from the mains power, the plug must be pulled out from the mains socket, therefore make sure the mains plug is always easily accessible.



Do not push or scratch the front filter, or place any objects on top of the TV set. The image may be uneven or the screen may be damaged.

To avoid the fire, no naked flame source, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the apparatus.



## Important Safety Instructions and Maintenance

### Installation



When the TV being moved in from cold place, it needs some right time for dew inside unit evaporating fully before turn on the unit;



To prevent injury, this apparatus must be securely attached to the floor/wall in accordance with the installation instructions.

### LED Screen

Although the LED screen is made with high precision technology and 99.99% or more of the pixels are effective, black dots may appear or bright points of light (red, blue or green) may appear constantly on the LED screen. This is a structural property of the LED screen and is not a malfunction. If the surface of the LED panel cracks, do not touch it until you have unplugged the AC power cord. Otherwise electric shock may result. Do not throw anything at the TV set. The LED panel may break from the impact and cause serious injury.

### Precautions When Displaying a Still Image

A still image may cause permanent damage to the TV screen. Do not display still images and partially still images on the LED panel for more than 2 hours as it can cause screen image retention. This image retention is also known as "screen burn". To avoid such image retention, reduce the degree of brightness and contrast of the screen when displaying a still image.

Watching the LED TV in 4:3 format for a long period of time may leave traces of borders displayed on the left, right and centre of the screen caused by the difference of light emission on the screen. Playing a DVD or a game console may cause a similar effect to the screen.

Damages caused by the above effect are not covered by the Warranty.

Displaying still images from Video games and PC for longer than a certain period of time may produce partial after-images. To prevent this effect, reduce the 'brightness' and 'contrast' when displaying still images.

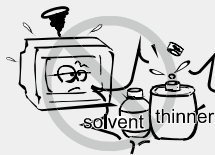
### Cleaning

Cleaning and handling the screen surface and cabinet. Disconnect the unit from the AC outlet before cleaning. To remove dust, wipe gently with a soft, lint free cloth. If required use a slightly damp cloth.



### MAINS PLUG

Wipe the mains plug with a dry cloth at regular intervals. Moisture and dust may lead to fire or electrical shock.



Use care not to subject the TV's surfaces to detergent. (A liquid inside the TV could lead to product failure, fire or electrical shock.) Use care not to subject surfaces to bug repellent, solvent, thinner, or other volatile substances as this may deteriorate the surface and finish of the cabinet.

## Important Information

If a television is not positioned in a sufficiently stable location, it can be potentially hazardous due to falling. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television.
- Only using furniture that can safely support the television.
- Ensuring the television is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.
- Not placing the television on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the television to a suitable support.
- Not standing the televisions on cloth or other materials placed between the television and supporting furniture.
- Educating children about the dangers of climbing on furniture to reach the television or its controls.
- Keep small accessories out of reach of children so they are not mistakenly swallowed.

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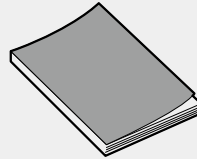

If you need to remove or assemble the stand please read the following instructions.

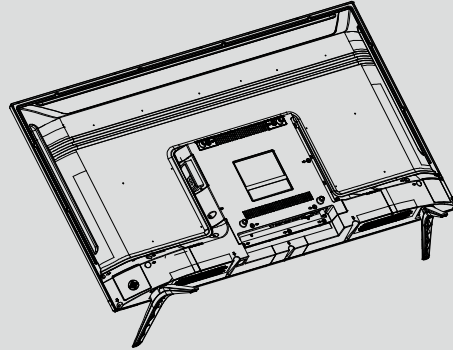
-Before attaching/detaching the stand, make sure to turn off the TV.

-Before performing work, spread cushioning over the base area to lay the LED TV on. This will prevent it from being damaged.

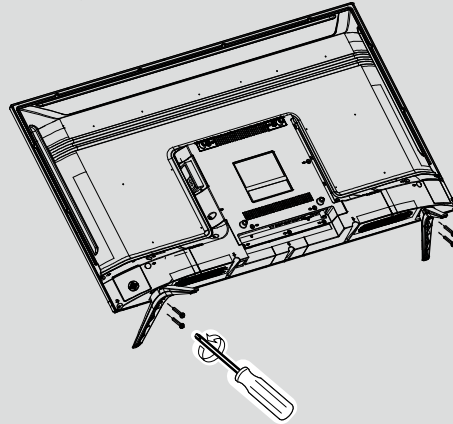
### Assembling instruction:

Step2: Take out four screws provided with TV set and tighten them into screw holes.

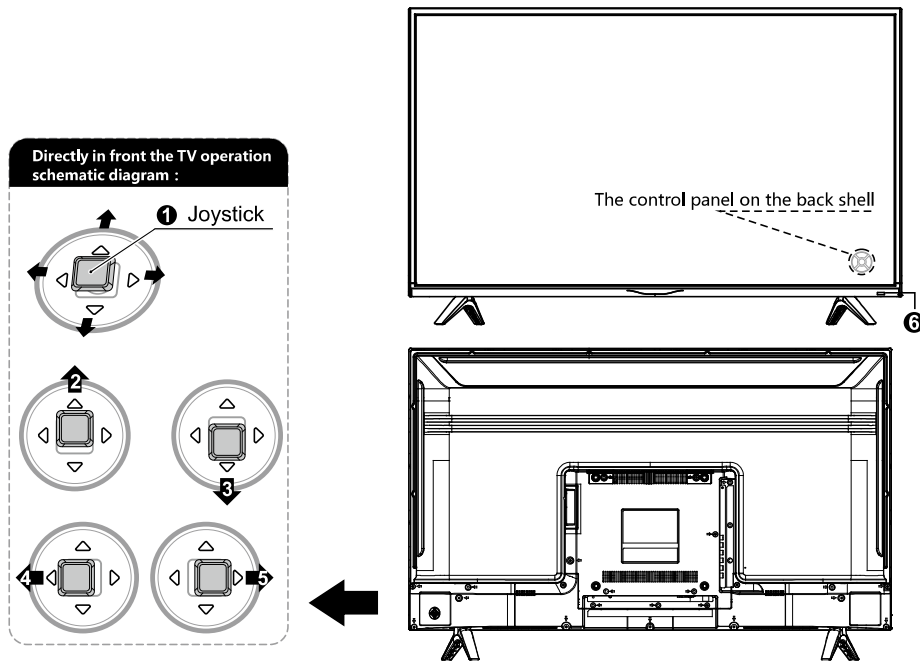




## General Description

### Overview of front panel

The buttons on the lower-right panel control your TV's basic features, including the on-screen menu. To use the more advanced features, you must use the remote control.

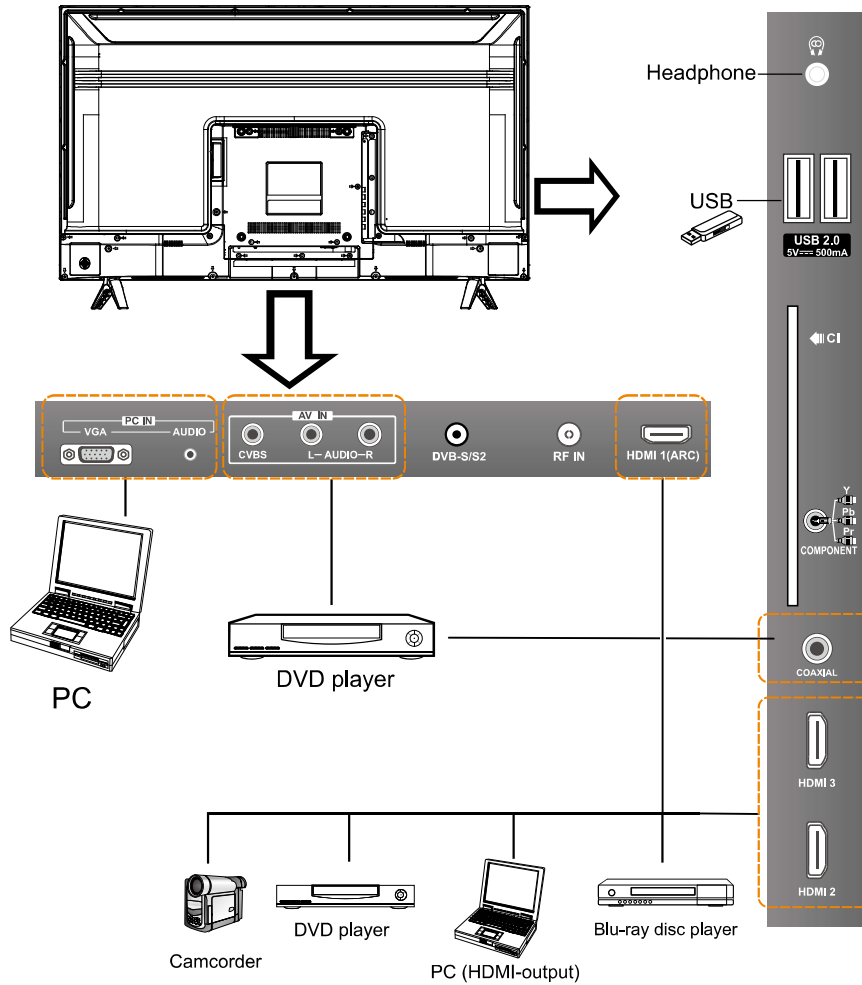


- 1** □ Centre    Press this button on the control panel one time as CONFIRM at any menu. Press and hold this button to display FUNCTION menu at any menu. Press and hold this button to turn on TV when it is in standby mode.

- 2** ↑ Up    Push one time: Use to select menu item if menu on TV. Use to go to last channel when watching TV.
- 
- 3** ↓ Down    Push one time: Use to select the next menu item if menu on TV. Use to go to next channel when watching TV. Push and hold this button to return to the last page.

- 4** ← Left    Push one time: Use to select the left menu item if menu on TV. Use to decrease volume when watching TV.
-

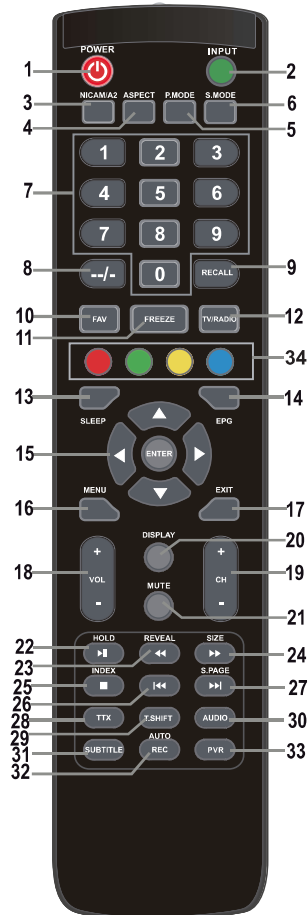

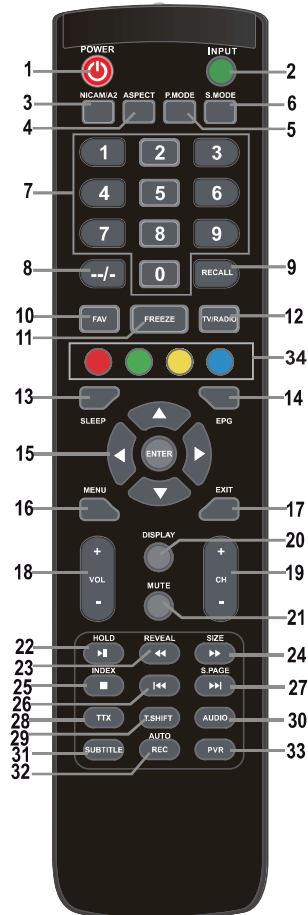
### Overview of Remote Control



1. **POWER:** Press this button to switch to standby mode, and press it again to turn TV on.
2. **INPUT:** Press to select the input source.
3. **NICAM/A2:** NICAM/A2 input.
4. **ASPECT:** Press this button to switch the screen mode.
5. **P.MODE:** This button is used to adjust user picture mode, press this button repeatedly and select one of four settings.
6. **S.MODE:** This button is used to select the sound mode.
7. **Digital buttons(0~9):** To select channel with digital buttons.
8. **-/-:** Press this button to enter a program number different digits. e.g.-for1,--for11, ---for111.
9. **RECALL:** Switch to the previous program.
10. **FAV:** Press it to display favorite list.
11. **FREEZE:** Freeze the picture.
12. **TV/RADIO:** Switching between the TV and radio modes.
13. **SLEEP:** Let you select amount of time before your TV turn itself off automatically.
14. **EPG:** In DTV source, this button is used to start the EPG application.
15. **Arrow buttons/ENTER:** Press these buttons to move cursor up/down/left/right for menu. ENTER button is used to select the sound mode.
16. **MENU:** Press to enter or exit the setup menu.
17. **EXIT:** Press exit to exit menu or sub menu.
18. **VOL +/-:** Press to increase/ decrease the sound level.
19. **CH +/-:** Press to scan through or to select a channel.
20. **DISPLAY:** Button for displaying the source and information about channels.
21. **MUTE:** Press this button to shut off sound of the TV, press again to restore TV sound.
22. **HOLD/▶|| :** Hold button: hold the current display. In the media mode: playback/pause.
23. **REVEAL/◀◀ :** REVEAL button: press REVEAL to display or hide hidden teletext information(depends on the broadcast).  
◀◀ button: fast rewind.

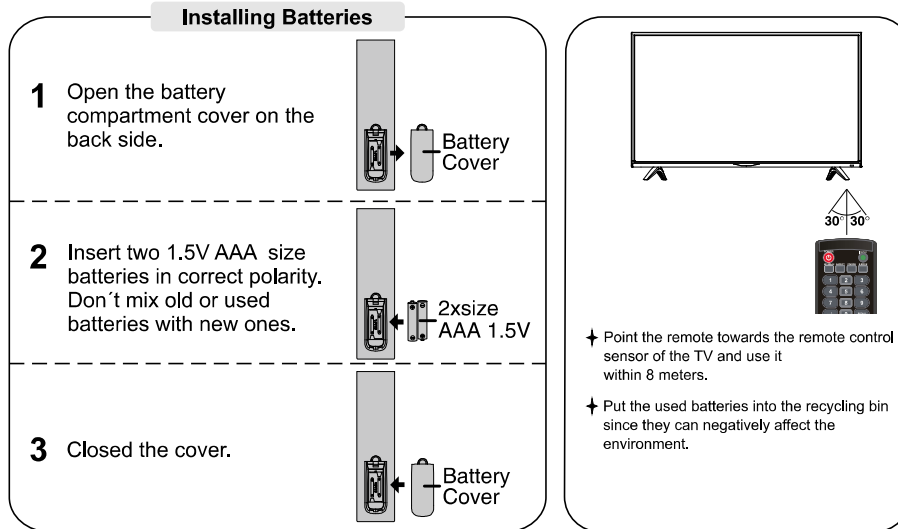

- 24. **SIZE/ ►►** : SIZE button: press size to change the size of the screen in the TTX mode.  
 ►► button: fast forward.
- 25. **INDEX/ ■** : Index button: call up a teletext content page.  
 ■ button: stop.
- 26. **◀◀** : In the media mode, skip to the previous track.
- 27. **S.PAGE/ ►►|** : S.PAGE button: press S.PAGE to enter a teletext sub page.  
 ►►| button: skip to the next track.
- 28. **TTX**: Turn teletext on or off.
- 29. **T.SHIFT**: It is used to start recording with a time shift. Function is only available in the DTV mode.
- 30. **AUDIO**: DTV mode: select a background sound, if available.
- 31. **SUBTITLE**: Press to switch the subtitles at the bottom of the screen, if they are available.
- 32. **AUTO/REC**: AUTO: Used for automatic configuration in the PC mode.  
 REC: Press to start recording. (only in the DTV mode).
- 33. **PVR**: It is used to enter/exit the PVR list menu.
- 34. **Red/Green/Yellow/Blue Command**: These four buttons are used to request linked buttons with the current menu/page.

### Installing Batteries in the Remote Control



#### NOTES:

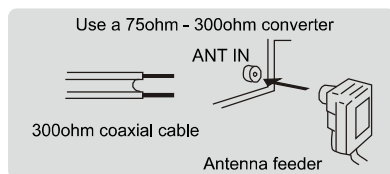
- One loading of batteries will last for 1 year under normal use.
- If you do not intend to use the remote controller for a long period of time, remove them to avoid damage due to leakage.
- Do not use old and new batteries together.
- The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) shall not exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

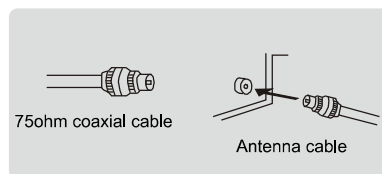
### Antenna connection

Antenna input impedance of this unit is 75ohm. VHF/UHF 75ohm coaxial cable can be connected to the antenna jack directly, if the antenna cable is 300ohm parallel flat feeder cable, you need to use the 300ohm/75ohm converter to connect the antenna cable to the antenna jack. For details Please refer to the following drawing.

#### Antennas with 75 Ω Round Leads

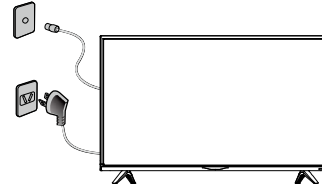


## Basic Operation

### Turning the TV On and Off

#### **How to turn the TV on or off**

1. Insert the power cord plug into a polarized AC outlet.
2. If TV is in standby mode, press **POWER** button on the remote control or  $\phi$  button on the back panel of LED TV.
3. Normal picture will be displayed on the screen after 15 seconds. If no signal input, "No Signal" will be displayed on the screen.
4. If temporary POWER off is required, press POWER button on the remote control or  $\phi$  button on the back panel.
5. If you want to completely switch off the power for this unit, unplug the power cord plug for this unit.
6. After switching off the unit, you should wait at least 5 seconds before switching on again.



#### **Status indication lamp**

Red: In standby mode.

Green: In power on mode.

#### **Auto power-off**

1. If there is no signal, the TV will automatically enter standby mode after 15 minutes.

#### **Memory before turning TV off**

The picture and sound settings and preset channels will be memorized at the point when the TV is turned off. When the TV is started up again it will work accordingly with these settings.

## Menu system instruction

### Select Input Source

Press INPUT button to display the input source list.  
Press ▼ / ▲ or ENTER button to select the input source you want.  
Press ENTER button to enter the input source, press EXIT button to quit.  
(Options: Satellite, DTV, ATV, AV1, AV2, PC, HDMI1, HDMI2, HDMI3, Media)



### First Time Installation

Connect an RF cable from the TV's input called "RF-In" to your TV Aerial socket.

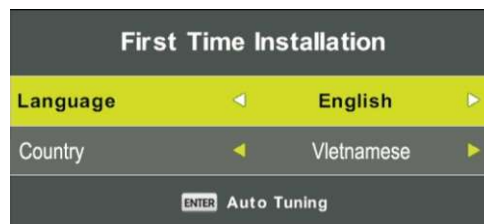
#### Select Language

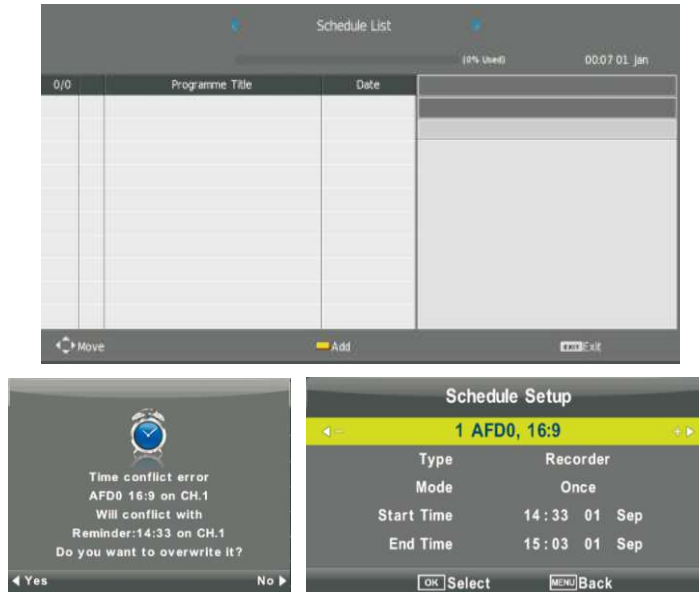

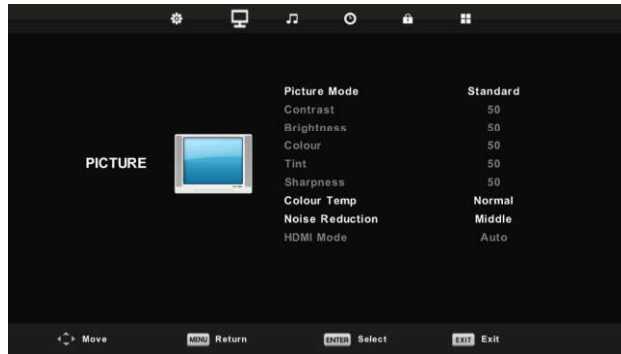

1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **PICTURE** menu.

### Picture Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Picture Mode, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.  
You can change the value of contrast, brightness, colour, sharpness and tint when the picture is in **Personal** mode.

TIPS: You can press PMODE button to change the Picture Mode directly.



### Contrast/ Brightness/ Colour/ Tint / Sharpness

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, then press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

**Contrast** Adjust the highlight intensity of the picture, but the shadow of the picture is nvariable.

**Brightness** Adjust the optical fiber output of the entire picture, it will effect the dark region of the picture.

**Colour** Adjust the saturation of the colour based on your own like.

**Tint** Use in compensating color changed with the transmission in the NTSC code.

**Sharpness** Adjust the peaking in the detail of the picture.

## Main Menu Operation

### Picture

#### Colour Temp

Change the overall color cast of the picture.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Colour Temperature, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select. (Available Picture mode: Cold, normal, Warm).

You can change the value of red, green and blue when the colour temperature is in **User** mode.



- Cold** Increase the blue tone for the white.
- Normal** Increase the sex-linked colors for the white.
- Warm** Increase the red color for the white.

#### Noise Reduction

To filter out and reduces the image noise and improve picture quality.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Noise Reduction, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.



- Off** Select to turn off video noise detection.
- Low** Detect and reduce low video noise.
- Middle** Detect and reduce moderate video noise.
- High** Detect and reduce enhanced video noise.
- Default** Set as Default.

#### HDMI Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select HDMI Mode, then press ENTER button to select the mode.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to select. (HDMI mode: Auto, video, PC).

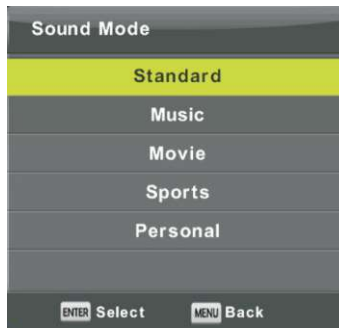
Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.  
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SOUND** in the main menu.



1. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **SOUND** menu.

### Sound Mode

TIPS: You can press **SMODE** button on the remote control to change the Sound Mode directly.

Standard	Produces a balanced sound in all environments.
Music	Preserves the original sound. Good for musical programs.
Movie	Enhances treble and bass for a rich sound experience.
Sports	Enhances vocals for sports.
Personal	Select to customize picture settings.

**Note:** The treble and bass are only available in **User** mode, you can adjust them as you like.

### Balance

Adjust the speaker's output, it enables you to listen to best at your position.  
Press ▼ / ▲ button to select option, press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

## Main Menu Operation

### Sound

#### Auto Volume level

Reducing the difference between channel and program's volume automatically.

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Auto Volume Level, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

#### SPDIF Mode

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select SPDIF Mode, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off / PCM / Auto.

#### AD Switch

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select AD Switch, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select On or Off.

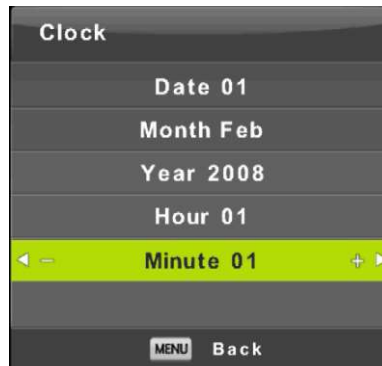

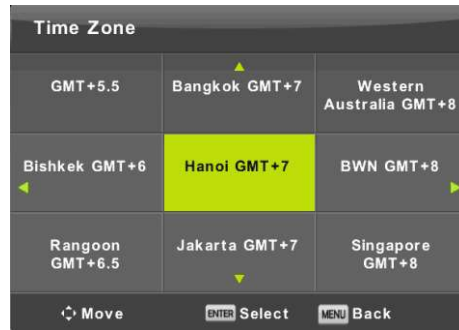

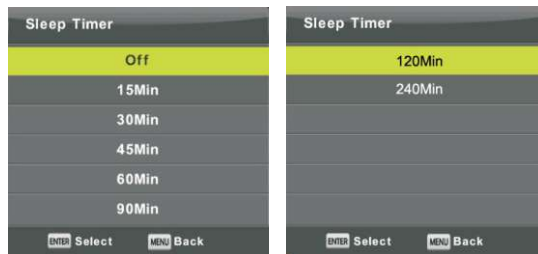

Tips: The remote control does not make any operation in the hypothesis time, it will close down automatically. If you do any operation, it will reset the time.

#### OSD Timer

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select OSD Timer, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.  
Press ◀ / ▶ button to select.

### Lock

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu.  
Press **◀ / ▶** button to select **Lock** in the main menu.



1. Press **▼ / ▲** button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **LOCK SYSTEM** menu.

3. After finishing your adjustment, Press **MENU** button to return back to the previous menu.

#### System Lock

Please remember that initial password is 2008.

Select System Lock with **▼ / ▲** button and then press **ENTER** button to select on/off to open or close the lock function



#### Set Password

Press **▼ / ▲** button to select Set Password, then press **ENTER** button to enter sub-menu to set new password.

#### Keyboard

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Keyboard, then press ◀ / ▶ button to select Off or On. When Key Lock's statue is on, you can't use the Key panel button.

Press MENU button to display the main menu. Press ◀ / ▶ button to select **SETUP** in the main menu.

## Troubleshooting

If you have any problem, check the counter measures for each symptom listed below. The following symptoms may have been caused by inappropriate adjustment rather than actual malfunction of the unit. If the trouble persists, contact the Customer Care Centre, see back page for contact details.

Symptoms	Possible solutions
No power	Please check the power cord plugged in and that the power outlet works. Unplug the power cord and plug it in after 60 seconds and restart the TV.
No picture	Please check antenna connection. Station may be experiencing problems, please tune to another station. Please adjust the settings of contrast and brightness.
Good picture but no sound	Please increase the volume. Please check TV is under mute mode, press MUTE button on the remote control. Please check sound settings If external devices are being used, check their volumes are not set too low or turned off. If using DVI to HDMI cable, a separate audio cable is required. Make sure a headphone jack is not connected..
Good sound but abnormal color or no picture	Please check antenna connection and antenna condition. If using Component input, please check Component connections, incorrect or loose connections may cause colour problems or cause the screen to be blank.
No response to remote control	Batteries of remote control may have exhausted, if necessary, please change the batteries. Clean the remote control lens. The distance between LED TV and remote control should be within 8m, within recommended operating angle and path is free of obstructions.
Full screen flickering under VGA	V-HEIGHT value may be set too big, restart computer and enter safe mode, then set monitor parameters to correct value according to adjustment description.
Horizontal stripes under VGA	Sample phase may be deflected, adjust phase according to picture position.
Colored dots may be present on the screen	Although the LED screen is made with high-precision technology and 99.99% or more of the pixels are effective, black dots may appear or bright points of light (red, blue, or green) may appear constantly on the LED screen. This is a structural property of the LED screen and not a malfunction.
Picture is breaking up	Keep the TV away from noisy electrical sources such as cars, hair dryers, welders, and all optional equipment. Electrical atmospheric interference such as local or distant lightning storms may cause picture to break up. When installing optional equipment, leave some space between the optional equipment and the TV. Check the antenna and connection. Keep the antenna away from any power or input/output cables.

## Troubleshooting

After Auto Tuning only some channels are available	Check your area is covered by Digital Video Broadcasts. Try re-tuning or manually tuning missing channels. Check that you are using the correct antenna type.
Channel cannot be selected	Check if the channel has been blocked in the main menu settings. It is available when the TV has channel block function.
USB not playing	Please check connecting USB cable and power supply is connected. Hard drive has not been formatted. Please make sure USB disk is compatible and the multimedia data formats are supported.
Picture is distorted, macroblock, small block, dots, pixelization, etc	Compression of video contents may cause distortion especially on fast moving pictures such as sports and action movies.
Noise from speaker	Check cable connections, make sure a video cable is not connected to an audio input. Low signal level may cause sound distortion.
TV turns off automatically	Sleep Timer may have been enabled. If there is no signal for about 15 minutes from an input, the TV will turn off. If connected to your PC, check your PC power settings. Make sure the AC power cord is plugged in securely to the wall outlet and the TV.
Picture is not shown in full screen	Black bars on each side will be shown on HD channels when displaying SD (4:3) contents. Black bars on Top & Bottom will be shown on movies that have aspect ratios different from your TV. Adjust picture size option on your external device or TV to full screen.

## WARNING

Never place a television set in an unstable location. A television set may fall, causing serious personal injury or death. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:
